*Topics covered* Diagnosis of Feline Herpes Virus, Update on the Treatment, Managing snotty nosed cats and Ocular manifestations of Systemic Disease.

**Solving Your Most Common Medical Problems** (01/08) October 2008, Professor Boyd Jones & Dr Caroline Mansfield (66pp)

*Topics covered are:* Seizures and Weakness, Weight loss and Anorexia and Polyuria & Polydipsia.

**Big Bellies: the bloated, bloody & sore abdomen** (05/07) November 2007. Drs Caroline Mansfield, Katrin Swindells, Griet Haitjema & Karen Staudte (54pp)

*Topics covered are:* Pathophysiology of acute abdominal distension, Stabilisation of acute abdominal distension cases, anaesthesia and analgesia for the patient with an acute abdomen & surgery of the acute abdomen.

**Soft Tissue Surgery & Ophthalmology** (04/07) August 2007. Drs Bryden Stanley & Simon Petersen-Jones (65pp)

*Topics covered are:* Impaired wound healing challenges, complications of intestinal surgery & how to deal with them, ten tips to improve surgery, examination of the eye, ocular emergencies & disorders of the lens.

**To Liver or Let Die** (01/07) February 2007. Drs Caroline Mansfield & Nola Lester (61pp)

*Topics covered are:* Clinical presentations of liver disease, biliary tract disease, diagnostic imaging of the liver.

**Endocrine Evaluation** (07/06) Printed December 2006. Drs Ian Ramsey & Anna Tebb (61pp)

*Topics covered are:* Dilemmas in diabetes including causes & investigation of unstable diabetes mellitus; Calcium conundrums including hyper & hypo calcemia causes & emergency treatment & other specific diseases; testing the thyroids – thyroid disease, investigations of the thyroid, endocrine tests for hypothyroidism & antibodies. Includes case study examples.

**Itchy, Scratchy Dogs & Cats** (06/06) October 2006. Dr Mandy Burrows (86pp)

*Topics covered are:* Feline facial dermatoses; feline eosinophilic skin diseases; canine pododermatitis & canine Otitis Externa.

**Cancer is NOT a Sentence** (05/05) August 2005. Drs Ken Wyatt, Gordon Corfield & David Davies (86pp)

*Topics covered are:* diagnosis of cancer, surgical oncology, treatment decisions, safe handling of cytotoxic drugs, paraneoplastic syndromes, canine lymphoma.

**Pocket Pets** (05/06) August 2006. Drs Brendan Carmel & Robert Johnson (176pp)

*Topics covered are:* Exotic pet practice – what's involved?; the rabbit in health & disease; the guinea pig in health & disease; ferret facts & adrenal associated endocrinopathy in ferrets; rat & mouse mammary tumours; Reptiles – behaviour in captivity, anaesthesia, sedation & pain relief, commonly occurring conditions in captive reptiles; introduction to small mammal anaesthesia & surgical concepts.
