This award is to the value of \$1,500.00 (AUD) and is open to postgraduate students working in any field of native fauna within the school of veterinary studies. The nature of the research is to avoid the use of vivisection “unless in exceptional circumstances”, and for the research to have relevance to the welfare and propagation of native fauna in their national environment. .

The award may be used to fund or supplement a research project, to cover travel expenses up to a maximum of \$1500 (AUD) to allow a postgraduate student to attend a conference or research meeting relevant to their field of research.

Applicants should forward a one page CV, together with a (maximum) 500 word proposal describing how the funds would be used. Deadline for applications is **19 October 2009**. Applicants will be notified by 14 November 2009.
